


CLIFFORD ALL SAINTS PRIMARY SCHOOL

We began by looking at what life was like in England under the Anglo-Saxons and how this changed with the first Viking raids. Our new class text 'Riddle of the Runes' is set in the fictional village of Kilsgard and we are using our reading to write character and setting descriptions. In PE we are very lucky to have Mrs Ashmore working with us from our PE Links partnership where we are working on our hockey skills.


