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The children have enjoyed planting this half term. Our sunflowers are growing quickly now and the children are very keen to measure the seedlings every day! So far our tallest seedling is 12cm. Last week the children also planted cress seeds. We have been watching them closely each day and the children have been pleased with how guickly they grow. We decided to put one of our plants in the cupboard to find

out what would happen if it was in the dark. We were surprised to see that it has grown although it is not as green as the cress that has been in the light. We are looking forward to taking our cress home this week to make sandwiches with!

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Y3 have investigated the reflective properties of different materials as part of their current science topic on light. Y3 also learnt about mummification and had a chance to observe/draw a 'genuine' open sarcophagus and handle some 'real

artefacts'

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In Y1 we have been learning all about plants! We know what a plant needs in order to grow and have been planting our own sunflowers as part of our science investigation. Year 1 had a fantastic time visiting the local Synagogue as part of our learning about Judaism this half term. The Rabbi shared lots of interesting stories and artefacts with the children.



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In Year 5 this half term we have been im mersed in the history of World War 1, as we investigated what life was like for a soldier. Many of the children researched and presented their own family's World One histories, with some fascinating stories shared. We also enjoyed a visit to the Ecclesall Woods Discov ery Centre, completing a woodland art workshop and team building

exercises - including learning how to make shelters and light fires.

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We are incredibly proud of all our Year 2s. They have been absolute superstars and worked so hard. We really enjoyed our treat afternoon where we ate ice-cream (yum), played together and watched Peter Rabbit! We have also been enjoying learning about plants in science with Miss Hirst. We created our own investigation where we put a runner bean in a ziplock bag. We put one in the cupboard and one on the window and we are looking at which one grows the quickest and healthiest. In history with Miss Milner we have been learning about the Victorians, including who Queen Victoria was, the inventions that happened during the Victorian era and the significant people that made changes during this time. Well done Year 2 - your Clifford team are all SO proud of vou!


Our pupil achievements uck Class
