Y1 Peak Adventure Trial Run

Dear All,

We are writing to let you know that as in previous years, there will be an overnight trip to the Rotary Centre in Castleton (where the school stays when it goes on Peak Adventure in Year 2) for parents and children.

There are a couple of reasons for doing this, primarily it gives the children (and parents) an opportunity to see the centre and to get a taste of what Peak Adventure will be like but also I am sure (and parents who have been previously have said) that it will be a fun time for us all, adults and kids!

This trip however is not organised by the school, it is completely organised by the parents and will only be a success and worthwhile if we have enough people sign up and enough people get involved.

A booking has been made for the centre for the 9 June, this is a Saturday night and we plan to stay for one night.

The cost of the centre is £350 per night for up to 30 adults and children. If more than 30 people want to stay each additional person will be charged at £10 per person. This means that if 30 children and their families want to come it will work out about £12 per person. This would be finalised when we know numbers. Other costs will be crafts, fish and chips on the Saturday night, hot chocolate on Saturday night, breakfast on the Sunday (cereals and toast etc). We ask that you bring your own packed lunch for Saturday as we plan to go on a walk on Saturday with lunch halfway through. The fish and chips will be ordered in advance and we will coordinate this nearer the time.

We all went on the practice 2 years ago and it was a real success and really helpful for the kids in preparation for the following year.

The plan is to eat together and to have activities similar to those they will do while they are away, craft, a walk, games etc. Once we have got an idea of numbers we can move forward with more of the specifics in terms of planning and organisation (we'll be looking for volunteers!). Please let us know whether you are able to come and how many places you require (in the past siblings have been able to come) by 9 February 2018. A child needs to have a responsible adult with them and it would be really helpful if you can let us know who that will be when you confirm you would like to come. Please can you also let us know if you would like to bring additional family members too and we will see if numbers allow this. We will then need to collect deposits after February half term.

We will send a further letter with more details when we have an idea of numbers and let you know about deposits etc. We will also begin to pull together both a timetable for the weekend and a list of jobs for people to volunteer for <sup>(1)</sup>
