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Duck class have started their journey around the world by learning about Africa. We have been reading the story Handa's Surprise and have used our different senses (including taste!) to learn about the fruits from the story. This week we have been learning about African animals. The children went on their own safari to

We have been exploring these big numbers and the different ways that they can be made with concrete resources. We have started our new book 'The Storm Whale' and we have created our own illustrations around this to help us retell the story. As part of our wider curriculum work, we have been learning all about the history of Sheffield. Lots of fabulous Year 1s have been spotting evidence of these around Sheffield!

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We have been learning about Amazing Africa and using our map skills to identify all the countries in Africa. We also identified continents and oceans around the

In maths, we have been exploring multiplication facts for the 10x tables and using pictorial representations to show our understanding in different ways.

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In computing, Year 3 really enjoyed learning about presentation using PowerPoint, which culminated in all the chil-

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In year 4, we have been learning about how we manage our feelings and emotions.
